PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PUNJAB REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION REGARDING THE GHAZI UNIVERSITY, DERA GHAZI KHAN (AMENDMENT) BILL 2015 (BILL NO. 24 OF 2015)

The Ghazi University, Dera Ghazi Khan (Amendment) Bill 2015 (Bill No.24 of 2015) was referred to the Standing Committee on Education on 21 May 2015. The Committee considered the bill in its meeting held on 2 June 2015.

- 3. Dr Shoaib Anwar, Additional Secretary, Government of the Punjab, Higher Education Department and Mr Mohsin Bukhari, Deputy Director, Law and Parliamentary Affairs Department represented their Departments. Hafiz Muhammad Shafiq Adil, Special Secretary, Provincial Assembly of the Punjab functioned as Secretary to the Committee.
- 4. The Additional Secretary, Higher Education Department apprised the Committee about the aims and objects of the Bill. He said that through the proposed Bill, the Government had decided to give proper representation of female experts in the Academic Council as well as in the Selection Board of the University. He requested the Committee that the Bill, as introduced, may be recommended for passage by the Assembly.
- 5. The Committee after hearing the Members, having the view point of the Administrative Department as well as Law & Parliamentary Affairs Department and discussing various points, unanimously decided to recommend that the Bill may be passed by the Assembly subject to the following amendments:-

AMENDMENT IN THE BILL

(1) PREAMBLE

- (i) the word "Whereas" occurring at the beginning be omitted and the word "it" be substituted by the word "It"; and
- (ii) the words "It is enacted as follows" be substituted by the words "Be it enacted by the Provincial Assembly of the Punjab as follows".

(2) CLAUSE 3

in sub-clause (1), in para (b), the word "three" occurring in line 2, the word "two" be substituted.

6. A copy of the Bill as introduced in the Assembly is at Annexure-A and a copy of the Bill as recommended by the Committee is at Annexure-B.
