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PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PUNJAB REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION REGARDING THE ALI INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION LAHORE (AMENDMENT) BILL 2015 (BILL NO. 47 OF 2015)

The Ali Institute of Education Lahore (Amendment) Bill 2015 (Bill No. 47 of 2015) was referred to the Standing Committee on Education on 7 October 2015. The Committee considered the Bill in its meetings held on 2 November 2015 and 24 February 2016.

3. Mr Irfan Ali, Secretary to Government of the Punjab, Higher Education Department and Mr Mohsin Abbas Syed, Director, Law and Parliamentary Affairs Department represented their Departments. Mr Faiz-ul-Basit, Additional Secretary (Committees), Provincial Assembly of the Punjab functioned as Secretary to the Committee.

4. The Secretary to Government of the Punjab, Higher Education Department apprised the Committee about the aims and objects of the Bill. He said that it was necessary to amend the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010 (II of 2010) for increasing the scope of education being imparted at the Institute aimed at improvement of teaching skills for teachers in different disciplines. He requested the Committee that the Bill, as introduced, may be recommended for passage by the Assembly.

5. The Committee after hearing the Members, having view point of the Administrative Department as well as the Law and Parliamentary Affairs Department and discussing various points, unanimously decided to recommend that the Bill may be passed by the Assembly subject to the following amendments:—

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AMENDMENTS IN THE BILL

(1) CLAUSE 1

in sub clause (1), the figures "2015" be substituted by the figures "2016".

(2) CLAUSE 2

(i) in sub clause (a), for the proposed clause (i) of section (1) of section 4 of the Principal Act, the following be substituted –

“(i) provide instructions and training in the faculty of education aimed at improvement of teaching skills for teachers in different disciplines as the Board may determine; subject to the prior approval of the relevant statutory body of professional education;”;
and

(ii) sub clause (b) be omitted and sub clause (c) be re-numbered as sub clause (b).

6. A copy of the Bill as introduced in the Assembly is at Annexure-A and a copy of the Bill as recommended by the Committee is at Annexure-B.

THE ALI INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION LAHORE (AMENDMENT) BILL 2015

A
BILL

to amend the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010.

It is necessary to amend the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010 (II of 2010) for increasing the scope of education being imparted at the Institute and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by Provincial Assembly of the Punjab as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be cited as the Ali Institute of Education Lahore (Amendment) Act 2015.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment in section 4 of Act II of 2010.— In the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010 (II of 2010), in section 4, in subsection (1):

- (a) for clause (i), the following shall be substituted:
 - “(i) provide instructions and training in the faculty of education and such other branches of knowledge as the Board may, with the approval of the Patron given on the recommendation of a committee constituted by the Government, determine and, where applicable, subject to the prior approval of the relevant statutory body of professional education;”;
- (b) in clause (ii), for the words “teachers education”, the word “knowledge” shall be substituted; and
- (c) for clause (iv), the following shall be substituted:
 - “(iv) hold examinations in the prescribed manner and, if a person qualifies the examination, award a degree, certificate and any other academic distinction to the person;”.

3. Repeal.— The Ali Institute of Education Lahore (Amendment) Ordinance, 2015 (XXIX of 2015) is hereby repealed.

to amend the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010.

It is necessary to amend the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010 (II of 2010) for increasing the scope of education being imparted at the Institute and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by Provincial Assembly of the Punjab as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be cited as the Ali Institute of Education Lahore (Amendment) Act 2016.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment in section 4 of Act II of 2010.— In the Ali Institute of Education Lahore Act 2010 (II of 2010), in section 4, in subsection (1):

(a) for clause (i), the following shall be substituted:

“(i) provide instructions and training in the faculty of education aimed at improvement of teaching skills for teachers in different disciplines as the Board may determine; subject to the prior approval of the relevant statutory body of professional education;” and

(b) for clause (iv), the following shall be substituted:

“(iv) hold examinations in the prescribed manner and, if a person qualifies the examination, award a degree, certificate and any other academic distinction to the person;”.

3. Repeal.— The Ali Institute of Education Lahore (Amendment) Ordinance, 2015 (XXIX of 2015) is hereby repealed.
