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PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PUNJAB REPORT OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE NO.1 REGARDING THE PUNJAB TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) BILL 2018 (BILL NO. 32 OF 2018)

The Punjab Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority (Amendment) Bill 2018 (Bill No.32 of 2018) was referred to the Special Committee No.1 on 12 December 2018. The Committee considered the Bill in its meetings held on 26 December 2018 and 2 January 2019.

3. Mr Nadeem-ur-Rehman, Secretary to Government of the Punjab, Industries, Commerce and Investment Department and Mr Mohsin Bukhari, Additional Director, Law and Parliamentary Affairs Department represented their Departments. Mr Inayatullah Lak, Director General (Parliamentary Affairs and Research), Provincial Assembly of the Punjab, functioned as Secretary to the Committee as well as Mr Faiz-ul-Basit, Additional Secretary (Committees) represented the Assembly Secretariat.

Since Raja Yawar Kamal Khan, MPA (PP-25) Convener Special Committee No.1 could not attend the meeting of the Committee on 2 January 2019 due to some other engagements, Syed Yawar Abbas Bukhari, MPA (PP-1) in terms of rule 151(2) of the Rules of Procedure of the Provincial Assembly of the Punjab 1997, was chosen to act as Convener for that sitting.

5. Mr Nadeem-ur-Rehman, Secretary to Government of the Punjab, Industries, Commerce and Investment Department apprised the Committee about the aims and objects of the proposed Bill (Bill No 32 of 2018). He stated that it was necessary to amend the Punjab Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority Bill to give effect to the regulatory, administrative and operational autonomy to the Punjab Skills Development Authority. He requested the Committee that the Bill as introduced may be recommended to be passed by the Assembly.

6. The Committee after hearing the members, having view point of the Administrative Department as well as the Law and Parliamentary Affairs Department and discussing various points, unanimously decided to recommend that the Bill may be passed by the Assembly subject to the following amendments: -

AMENDMENTS IN THE BILL

(1) LONG TITLE

the word "further" be added before the words "to amend".

(2) CLAUSE 1

in sub-clause (1), the figures "2018" be substituted by the figures "2019".

7. A copy of the Bill as introduced in the Assembly is at Annexure-A and a copy of the Bill as recommended by the Committee is at Annexure-B.

THE PUNJAB TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) BILL 2018

*to amend the Punjab Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority Act
2010*

It is necessary further to amend the Punjab Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority Act 2010 (*X of 2010*) to give effect to the regulatory, administrative and operational autonomy to the Punjab Skills Development Authority.

Be it enacted by Provincial Assembly of the Punjab as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be cited as the Punjab Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority (Amendment) Act 2018.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment in section 5 of Act X of 2010.— In the Punjab Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority Act 2010 (*X of 2010*), in section 5, in subsection (1):

(a) clause (d), clause (f) and clause (j) shall be omitted; and

(b) in clause (n), the expression "and may approve or licence a hostel," shall be omitted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS
