REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON HOME REGARDING ""THE ANTI-TERRORISM (PUNJAB AMENDMENT) BILL 2025 (BILL NO. 71 OF 2025"

- 3. Mr Imran Hussain Ranjha, Additional Secretary (Judicial), Government of the Punjab, Home Department and Mr Shan Ul Haq, Special Director, Law & Parliamentary Affairs Department, represented their respective departments. Mr Khalid Mahmood, Secretary (Parliamentary Affairs), Provincial Assembly of the Punjab, functioned as Secretary to Committee.
- 4. The Additional Secretary (Judicial), Home Department apprised the Committee about the objects and reasons of the Bill. He stated that recent wave of terrorism necessitates extra-ordinary measures and it is expedient to confer the power of preventive detention for the purposes of inquiry to the law enforcement agencies for the period of two years as a temporary arrangement. He requested that the Bill, as introduced, may be recommended for passage by the Assembly.
- 5. The Committee, after hearing the members, having viewpoints of the Administrative Department and Law & Parliamentary Affairs Department and having detailed deliberations, decided to recommend the bill, as introduced, for passage by the Assembly.

further to amend the Anti-terrorism Act, 1997.

It is necessary further to amend the Anti-terrorism Act, 1997 (XXVII of 1997) for the purposes hereinafter appearing.

It is hereby enacted by Provincial Assembly of the Punjab as follows:

- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) This Act may be cited as the Anti-terrorism (Punjab Amendment) Act 2025.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of section 11EEEE of Act XXVII of 1997.- In the Anti-terrorism Act, 1997 (XXVII of 1997), in section 11EEEE:
 - (a) in sub-section (1), after the existing proviso, for the full stop, colon shall be substituted and thereafter, the following shall be inserted:

"Provided further that provision of sub- section (3) shall not apply to such person.";

- in sub-section (2), for the existing proviso, the following shall be substituted:
 "Provided that where the detention order has been issued by the armed forces or civil armed forces under sub-section (1), the inquiry shall be conducted by the joint investigation team comprising of a police officer, not below the rank of Superintendent of Police, member of intelligence agencies, civil armed forces, armed forces and other law enforcing agencies."; and
- (c) for sub-section (2A) and the proviso thereunder, the following shall be substituted:
 - "(2A) The provisions of sub-sections (1) and (2) shall remain in force for a period of two years from the commencement of the Anti-terrorism (Punjab Amendment) Act 2025.".
