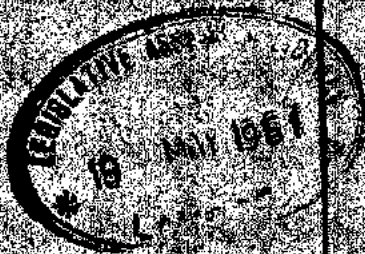

PUNJAB LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETINGS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PUNJAB LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY HELD ON 23RD JUNE 1947 AND 4TH JULY 1947 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATEMENT OF HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT, DATED THE 3RD JUNE 1947.

PARTITION OF THE PROVINCE

In order to take, on behalf of the respective areas, the decisions referred to in paragraphs 6 and 8 of the Statement, a meeting of the members of the Western Section of the Punjab Legislative Assembly representing the Muslim majority districts, the Hon'ble Diwan Bahadur S. P. Singha, Speaker of the Punjab Legislative Assembly, presiding, and a meeting of the members of the Eastern Section of the Punjab Legislative Assembly representing the areas other than the Muslim majority districts, Sardar Kapur Singh, Deputy Speaker of the Punjab Legislative Assembly, presiding, were held respectively in the Tea Room and in the Cabinet Room in the Assembly Building at Lahore on Monday, the 23rd June 1947, at 9 a. m.

Two Members in the Western Section, viz, Lala Bhim Sen Sachar and Malik Sir Muhammad Feroz Khan Noon, and two members in the Eastern Section, viz, Seth Sudarshan and Nawab Iftikhar Hussain Khan, having demanded in the respective sections that a meeting of all members of the Legislative Assembly (other than European) be held to take decision on the issue as to which Constituent Assembly the province as a whole would join if it were decided by the two parts of the Assembly to remain united, a joint meeting of the two parts of the Assembly was held in the Assembly Chamber at 9-30 a. m. in pursuance of the provision of paragraph 7 of the Statement, the Hon'ble Diwan Bahadur S. P. Singha presiding. It having been previously agreed by the Party Leaders that there should be no speeches, that voting should be by division, that no motion be made but the question be ascertained from the Chair, the procedure was approved by the House. Voting then took place which resulted as follows:—
